By Car

Aylsham Station is situated mid-way between Norwich and Cromer on the A140, making it easily accessible from London, East Anglia and the Midlands. Wroxham Station is in Coltishall Road, close to the town centre. There are large free car parks at both stations.

By Rail

Wroxham Station is adjacent to the Anglia Railways Bittern Line Wroxham (Hoveton) Station which offers direct services from Norwich, Cromer and Sheringham. For connecting train times, please call British Rail enquiries on 0845-7.48.49.50.

By Bus

First Eastern Counties run a regular service to both Aylsham and Wroxham.

By Boat

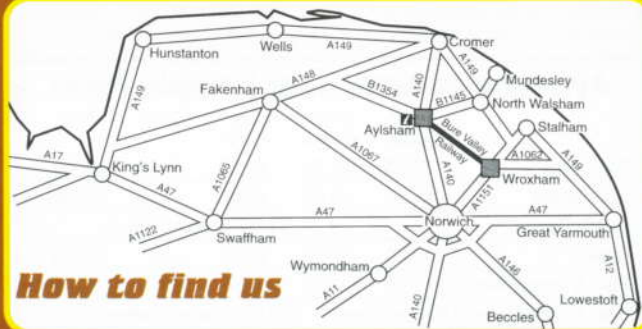

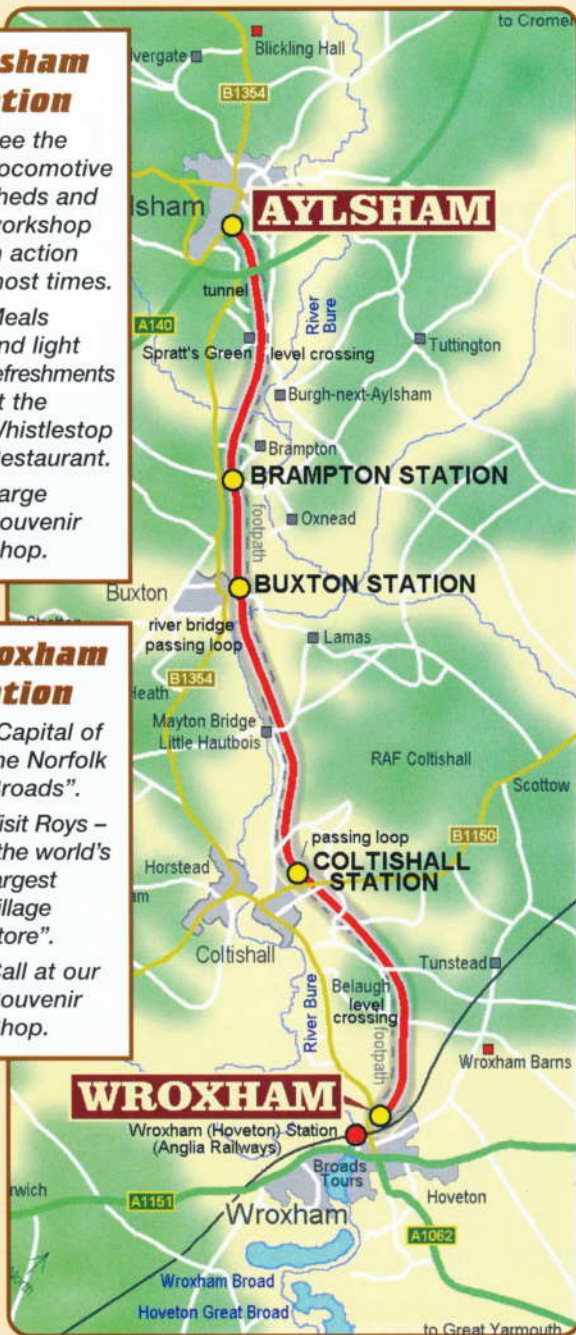
