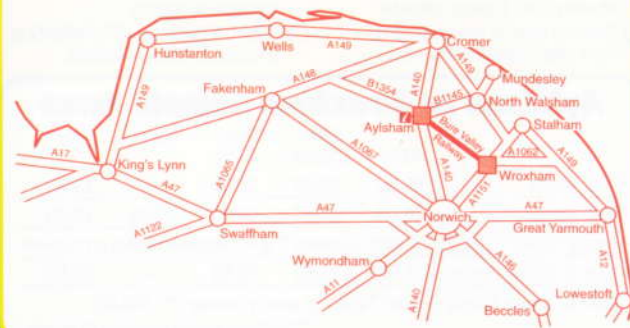

How to find us

- By Car** Aylsham is situated mid-way between Norwich and Cromer on the A140. The station is signposted as you approach Aylsham. Wroxham Station can be found on Coltishall Road (B1354), close to the town centre. There are large free coach and car parks for railway customers at both stations.
- By Rail** Wroxham Station is adjacent to the Bittern Line Railway Wroxham (Hoveton) Station which offers direct services from Norwich, Cromer and Sheringham. For connecting train times, please call National Rail enquiries on 0845-7.48.49.50.
- By Boat** Wroxham Station is situated a short walk from the town centre. This makes the Bure Valley Railway the most convenient tourist railway for anyone holidaying on the Broads.
- By Bus** First Eastern Counties run a regular service to both Aylsham and Wroxham.

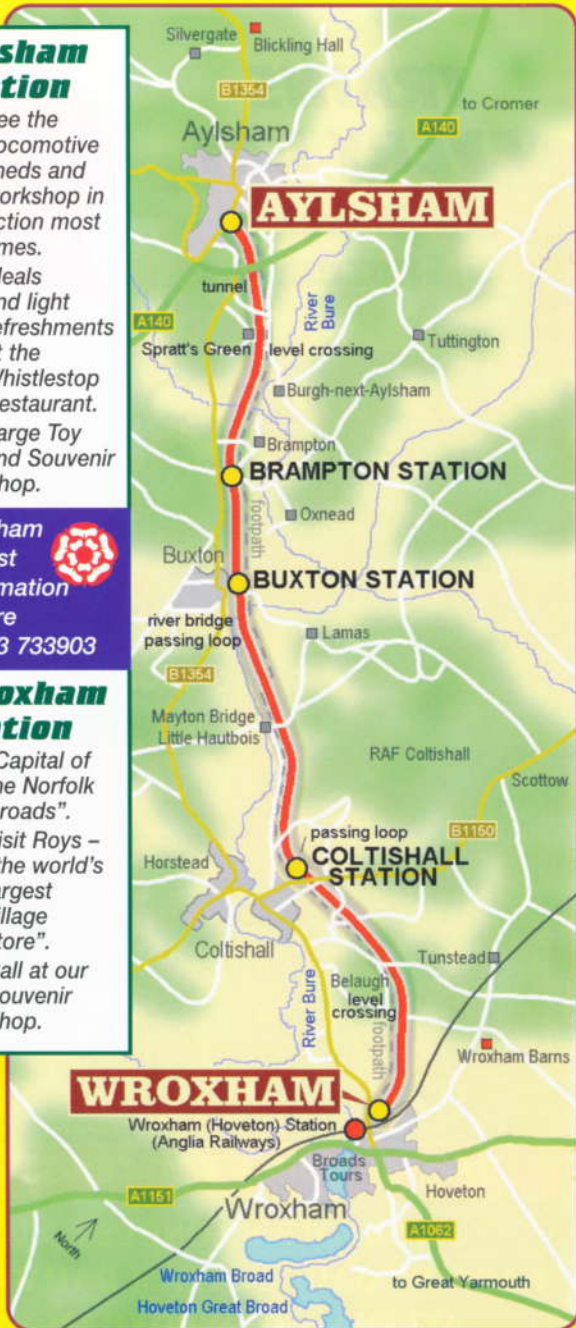
