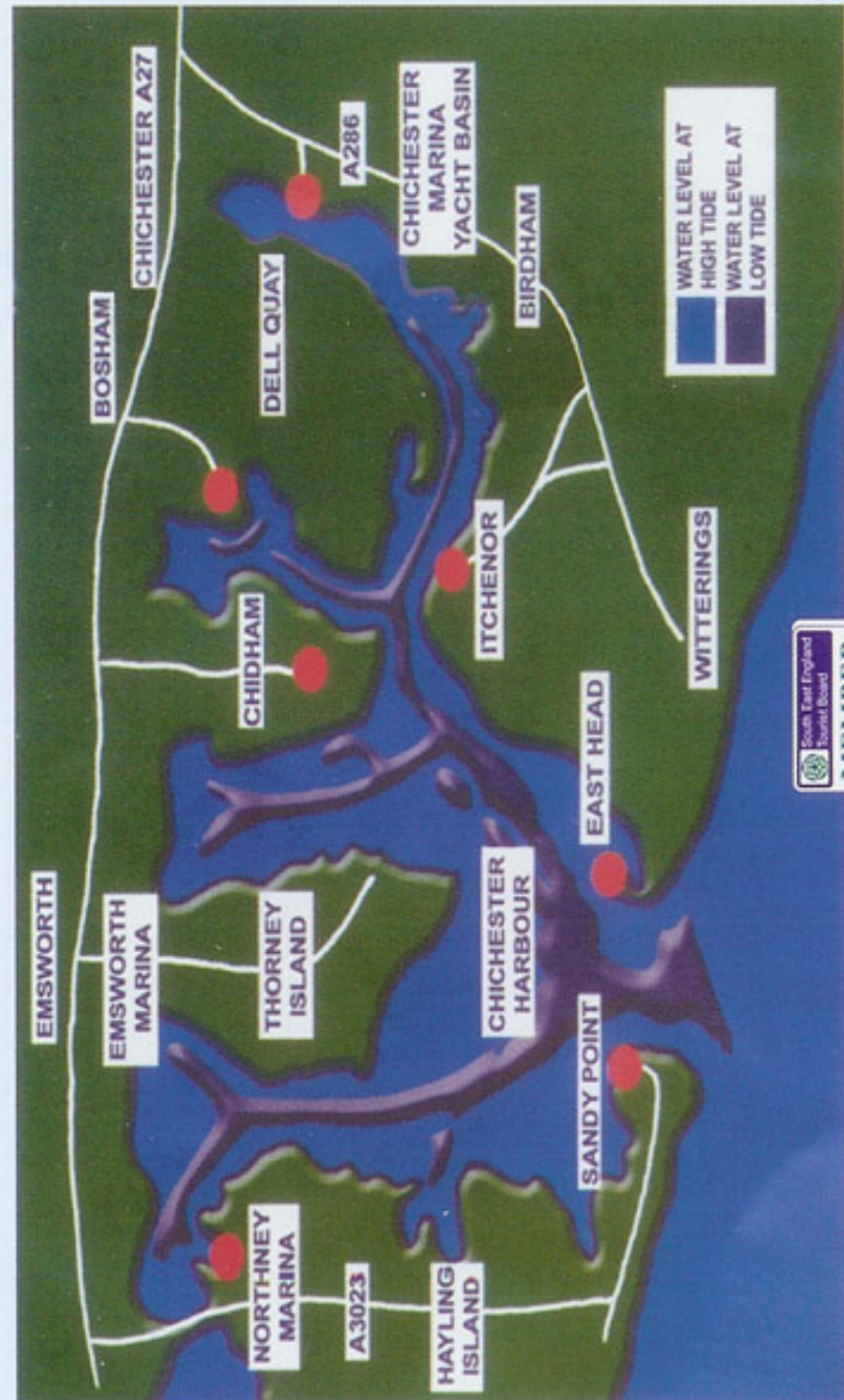


Directions to Itchenor

Signposted off the Chichester bypass and the A286 to the Witterings and Bracklesham. Continue along this road following the brown and white signs.

Wingate III

The Wingate III which carries 52 people is used for these tours is a traditional passenger boat. It is inspected annually and fully conforms to the rigorous requirements demanded by the Maritime and Coastguard Agency. The skippers are fully qualified to MCA standards.

The boat is fully insured to comply to school & local authority requirements.



Once aboard you will have the chance to appreciate the 48 miles of changing shoreline including a wide variety of habitats, including the three quaint villages of Bosham, Dell Quay and Itchenor.

There are sand dunes, mudflats shingle banks and woods; all a valuable refuge for seabirds and other interesting wildlife species.



Something for everyone

Throughout the winter there are trips at least once a fortnight for bird watching, to see the many migrant and local wading birds at close quarters.

There is also a large variety of wildfowl like Merganser, Shellduck and Teal to name a few, sea birds are abundant throughout the area with designated nesting sites, to encourage their numbers to grow e.g. Terns, Herons and Egrets.

There is a residential Seal population in the harbour, you may be in luck and see one.
