

## Timetable and Fares

### Northern and Southern Services

Use an around the lake ticket to either relax and enjoy a round trip on the boat, or hop on and off the boat throughout the day at our jetties and catch a later sailing back using the same ticket. If you break your Southern cruise at Brantwood, your ticket also allows you to return to Coniston jetty on the Northern Service.



### Take the Bus

Take advantage of the 'Ruskin Explorer' ticket including fares for Bus and Boat, plus Brantwood House. The 505 Stagecoach service runs from Windermere and Ambleside. Alternatively take the 525 Cross Lakes Experience from Bowness, via boat & bus. Buses interchange at the Waterhead Hotel where you can, if you wish, enjoy light refreshments before boarding the launch. ### Get Walking

Use our around the lake ticket to hop on and off as much as you like until you reach your point of departure.

Singles fares are also available to all destinations.

Pick up a free 'low level walks' leaflet on the launch.

Why not buy a pack of walk leaflets? These give you the freedom to plan 'one way' fell walks using our jetties.



### Private Cruises


