

Excursions from Reedham

Leaving from the Village Quay



Oulton Broad and the Waveney Valley

Cruising past St Olaves and Somerleyton we navigate two Victorian swing bridges and follow the railway line to picturesque Oulton Broad. Our berth lays between Everitts Park and the Broads southern gateway at Mutford Lock. **Approx 5 hours including shore time.**

Breydon Water and Windmills (4 hours)

As we leave Reedham the Victorian railway bridge swings open for our passage along the river Yare. We encounter Polkeys Windmill, the famous Berney Arms Inn, a Roman Fort at Burgh Castle and teeming wildlife as we cross Breydon Water. A modern bridge will lift for our mooring in the busy port of Great Yarmouth.

Breydon Water Explorer (1 1/2 Hours)

The bridge lifts admitting us onto the estuary of Breydon Water with its abundant wildlife. See the Roman Fort at Burgh Castle and the tallest windmill on the Broads.

Reedham Village and Windmills* (4 hours)

Cruising through panoramic Breydon Water and along the river Yare we pass Polkeys Mill and steam pump. A working Victorian railway bridge will swing open at the waterside village of Reedham for our quayside mooring.



Leaving from the Reedcutters Quay




Norfolk's Grandest Day Out

Meandering along the river Yare passing Hardley Cross and the last working chain ferry on the Broads we reach the charming riverside village of Reedham. A Victorian railway bridge there swings open for our passage past Polkeys Mill and the famous Berney Arms Inn. At the start of Breydon Water we see the substantial remains of a Roman settlement and then travel across the RSPB reserve of Breydon estuary with its teeming wildlife. A lifting bridge will admit us to the busy port of Gt. Yarmouth and Stonecutters quay.
