Leaving from the Lord Nelsons Quay

### Breydon Water and Windmills\*

As we leave Reedham the Victorian railway bridge swings open for our passage along the river Yare. We encounter Polkeys Windmill, the famous Berney Arms Inn, a Roman Fort at Burgh Castle and teeming wildlife as we cross Breydon Water. A modern day bridge will lift for our mooring in the busy sea port of Great Yarmouth.

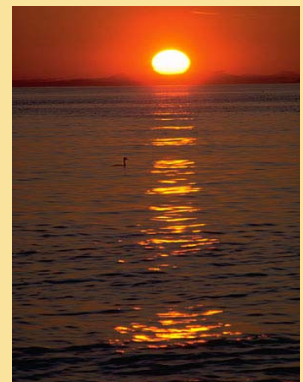

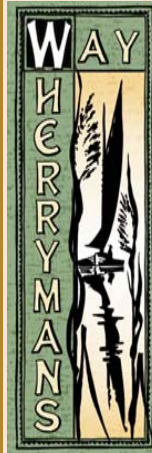
**Norfolk's Grandest Day Out**

At the beginning of Breydon Water we see the substantial remains of a Roman settlement and then travel across the RSPB reserve of Breydon estuary with its teeming wildlife. A lifting bridge will admit us to the busy port of Great Yarmouth and our berth on Stonecutters quay.
